## Drawing your name in 3D!

## Setting up your drawing

— - -

1. Get a large piece of white paper or tape two smaller pieces of paper together
2. Draw a horizon line near the top of your paper

3. Add a vanishing point in the middle

## Add Your Name

1. Draw your first name in block letters
a. Your name can be in all caps or you can use small letters
2. Make sure you leave space between each letter
a. If you don't, you won't have enough room for the 3D element
3. If you have a long name, you can draw a nickname


## Create 3D Letters

1. Connect the edges of your letters to your vanishing point using a ruler

2. Create parallel lines behind each section of your letter
3. Erase connecting lines
4. Do this ONE LETTER AT A TIME
5. If you need a review of how to create 3D letters with one-point perspective, go back and watch the video


## Finalizing your letters and looking ahead
