One-Point Perspective Letters

Drawing your name in 3D!

Setting up your drawing


 Get a large piece of white paper or tape two smaller pieces of paper together

Draw a horizon line near the top of your paper

3. Add a vanishing point in the middle


Add Your Name

- Draw your first name in block letters
 - a. Your name can be in all caps or you can use small letters
- Make sure you leave space between each letter
 - a. If you don't, you won't have enough room for the 3D element
- 3. If you have a long name, you can draw a nickname



Create 3D Letters

- Connect the edges of your letters to your vanishing point using a ruler
- 2. Create parallel lines behind each section of your letter
- 3. Erase connecting lines
- 4. Do this ONE LETTER AT A TIME
- 5. If you need a review of how to create 3D letters with one-point perspective, go back and watch the video
